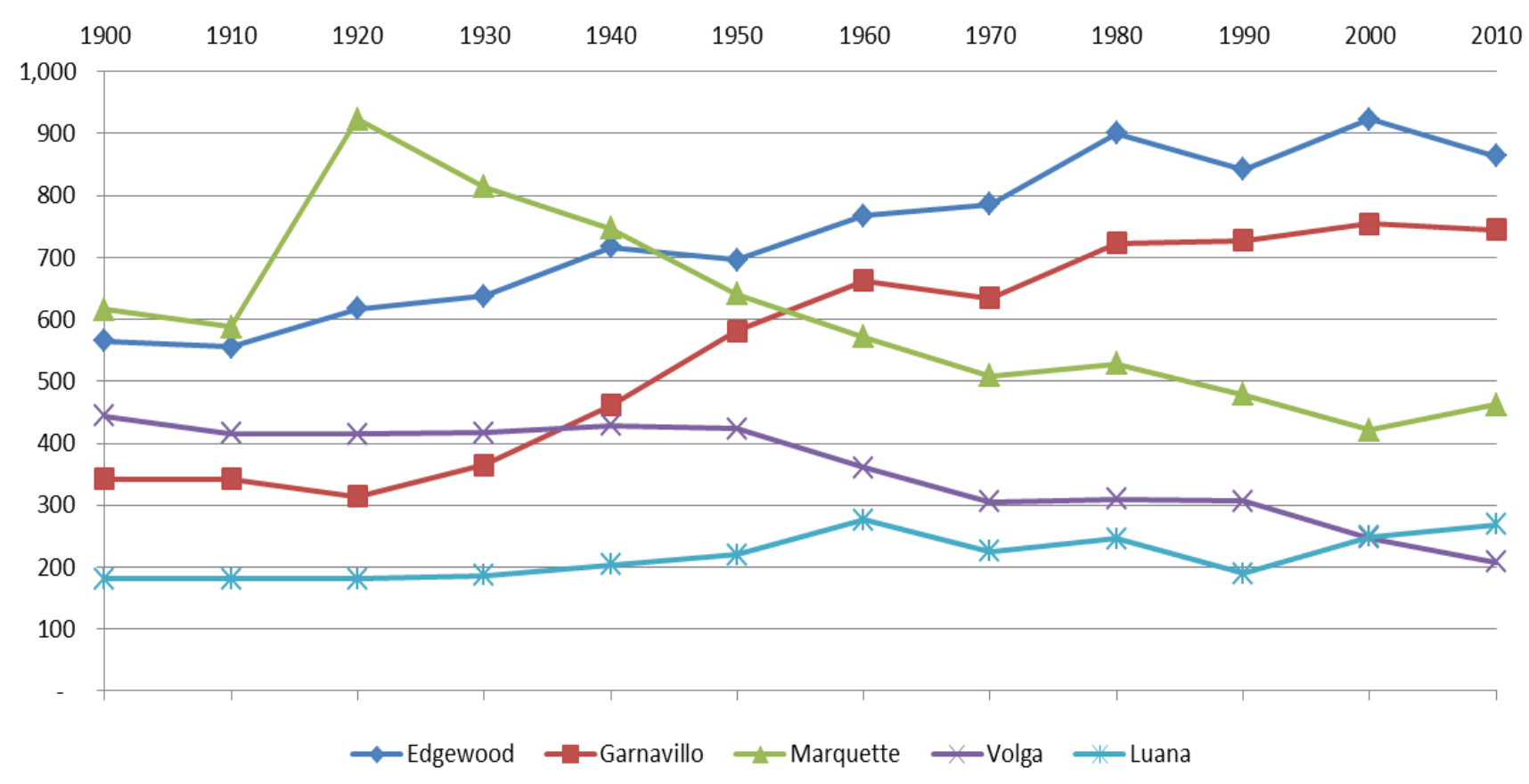

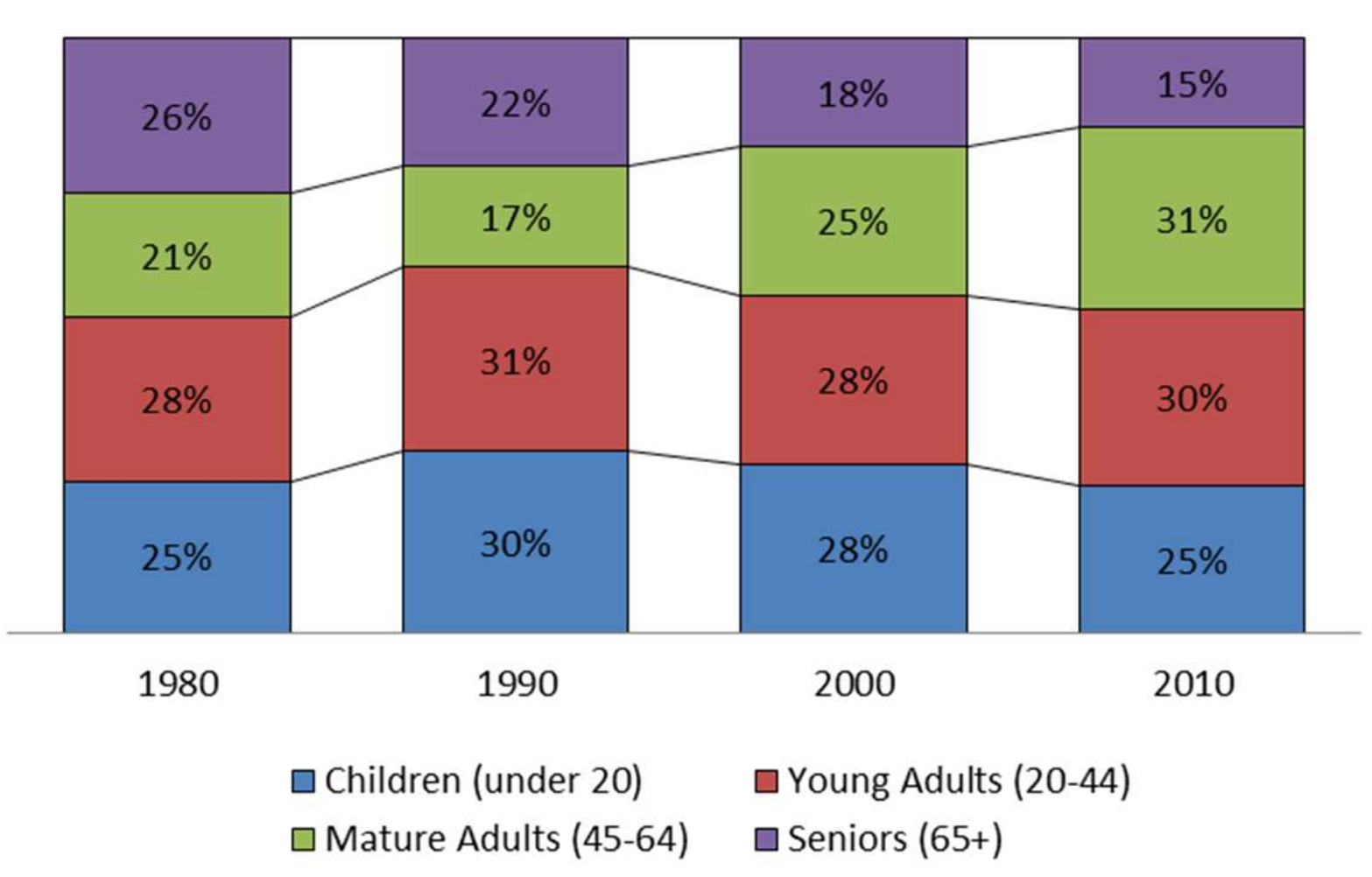

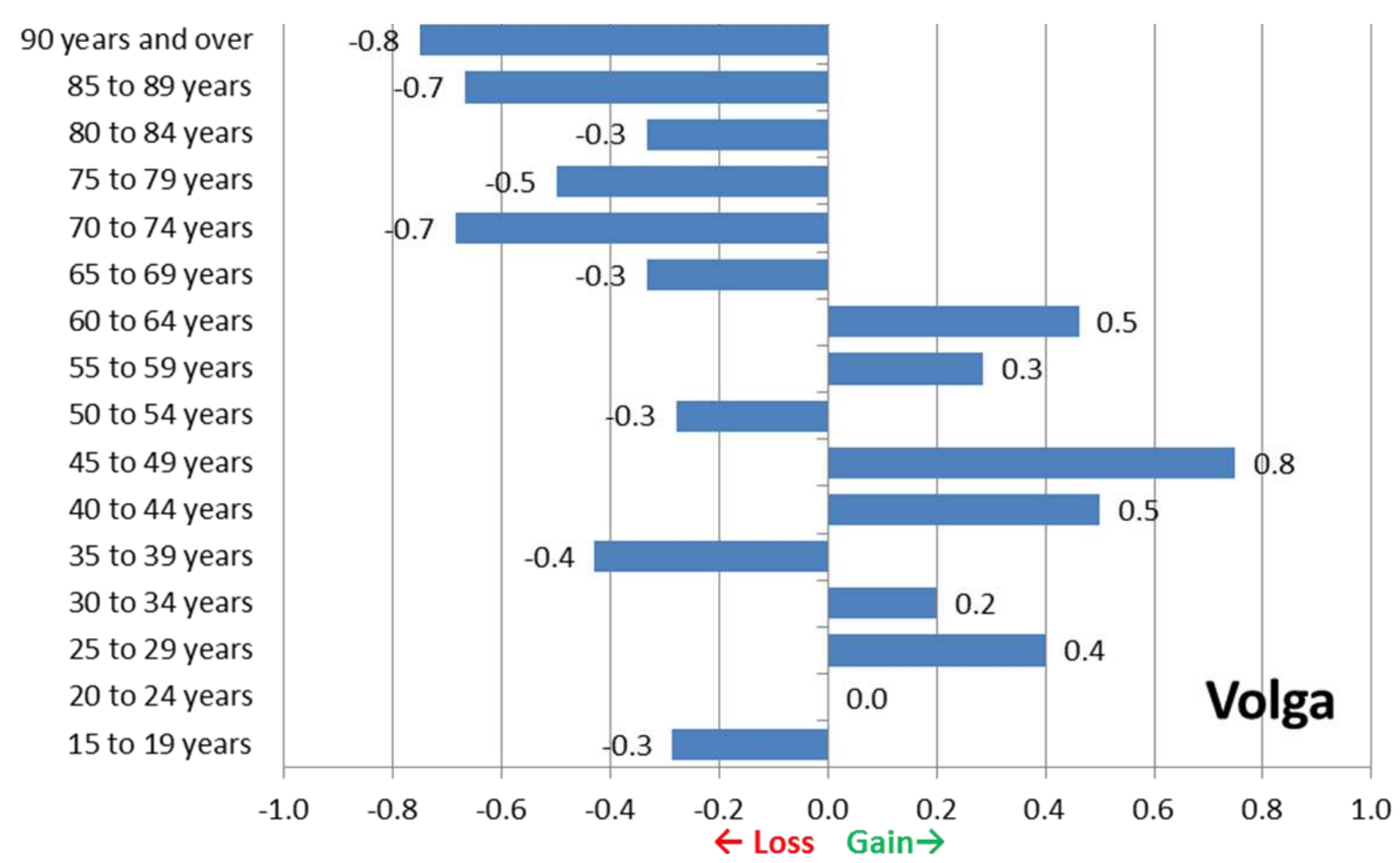
Population, Historical



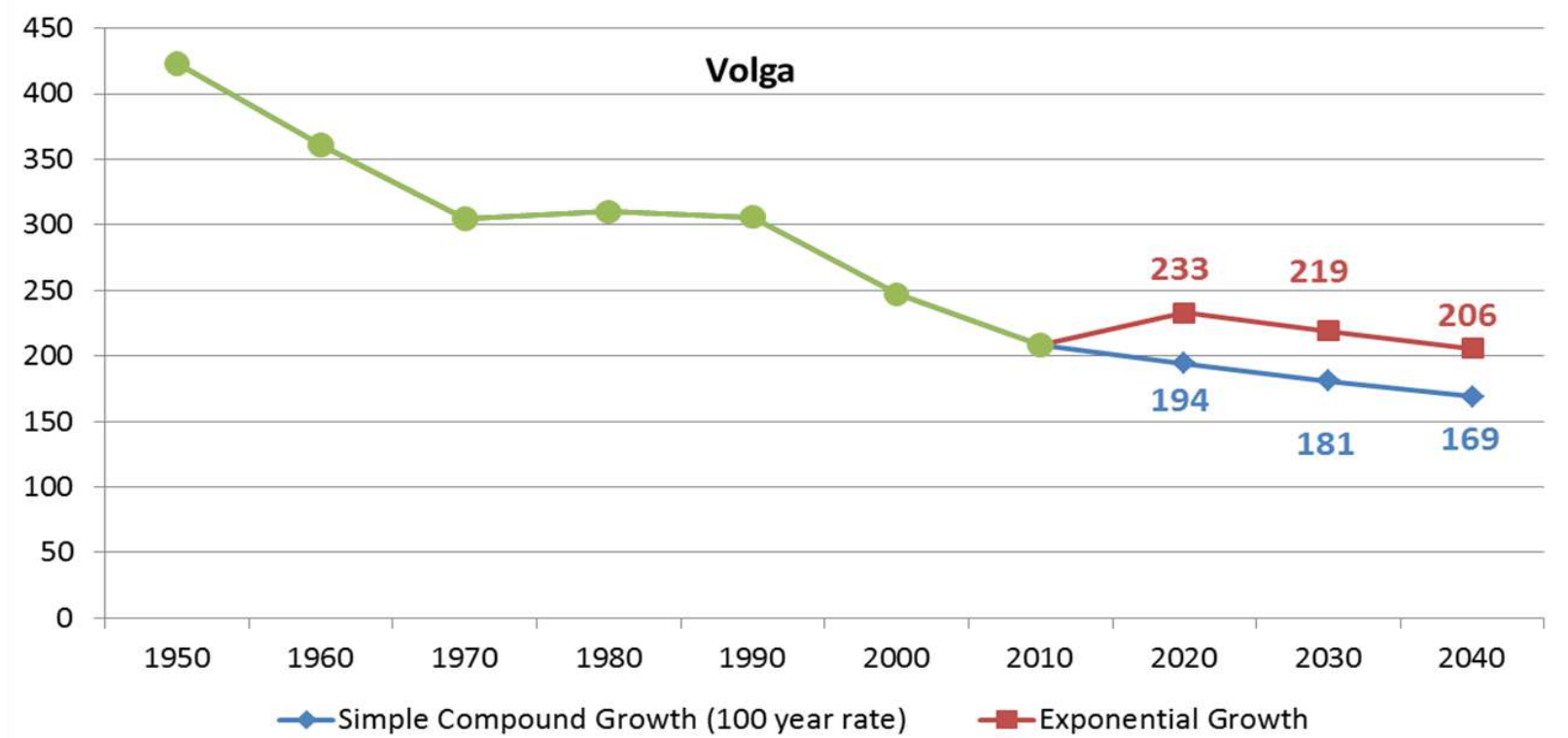
Age Group Distribution



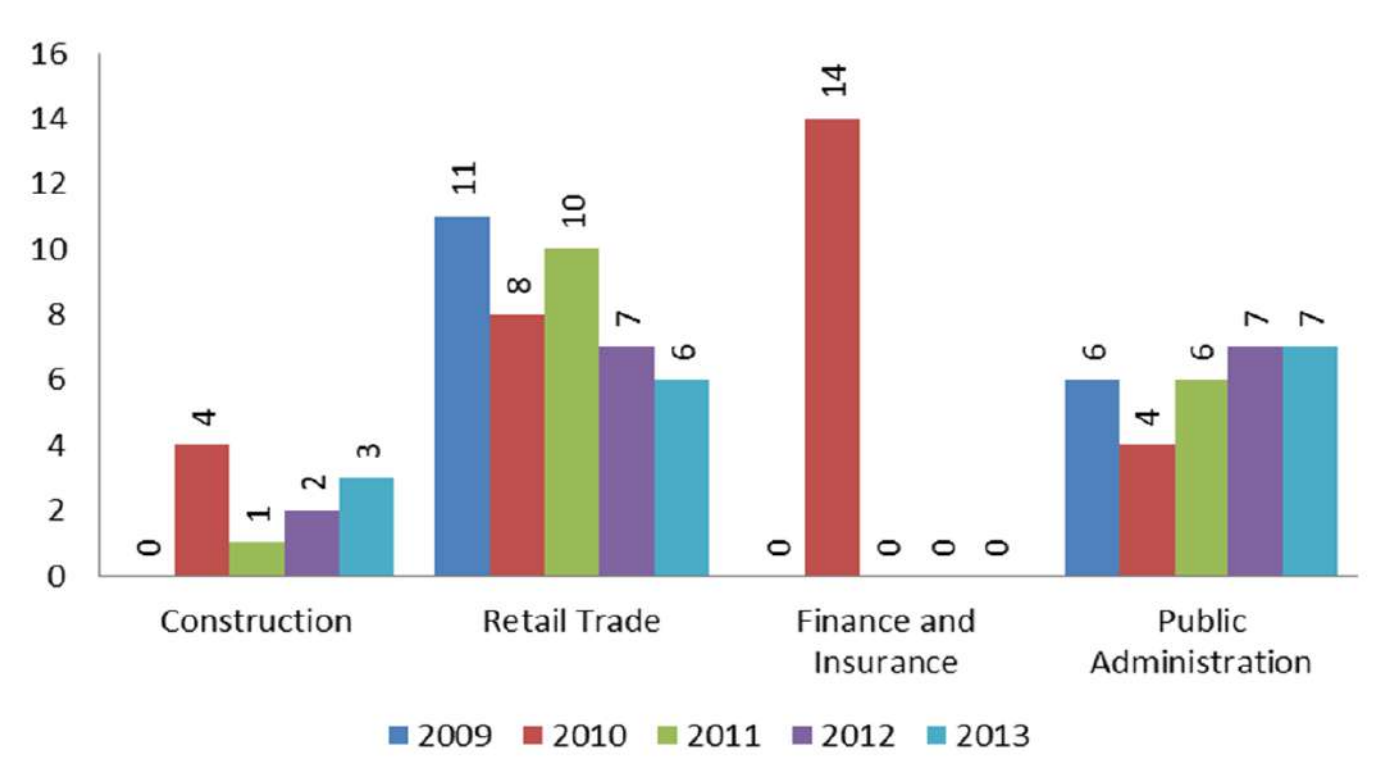
Net Population Loss/Gain by Age Group



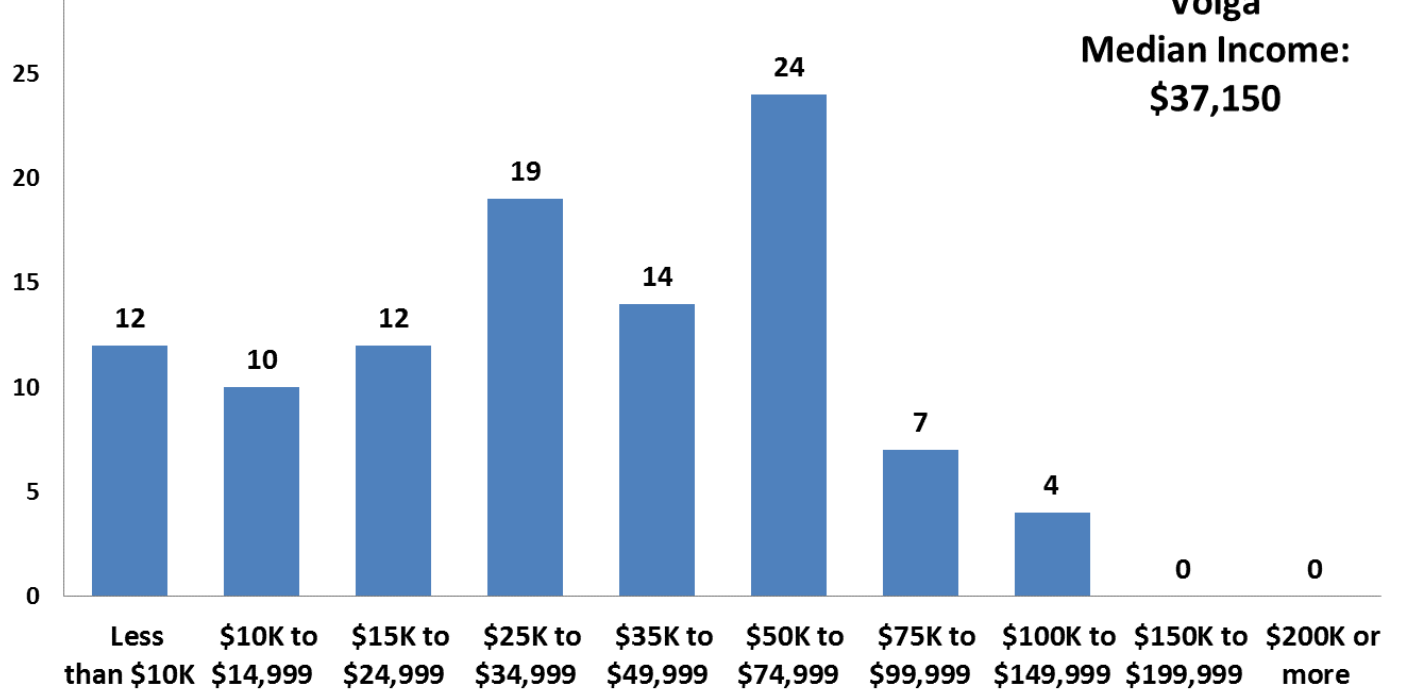
Population Projections



Top Four Employing Industries (Primary Jobs)



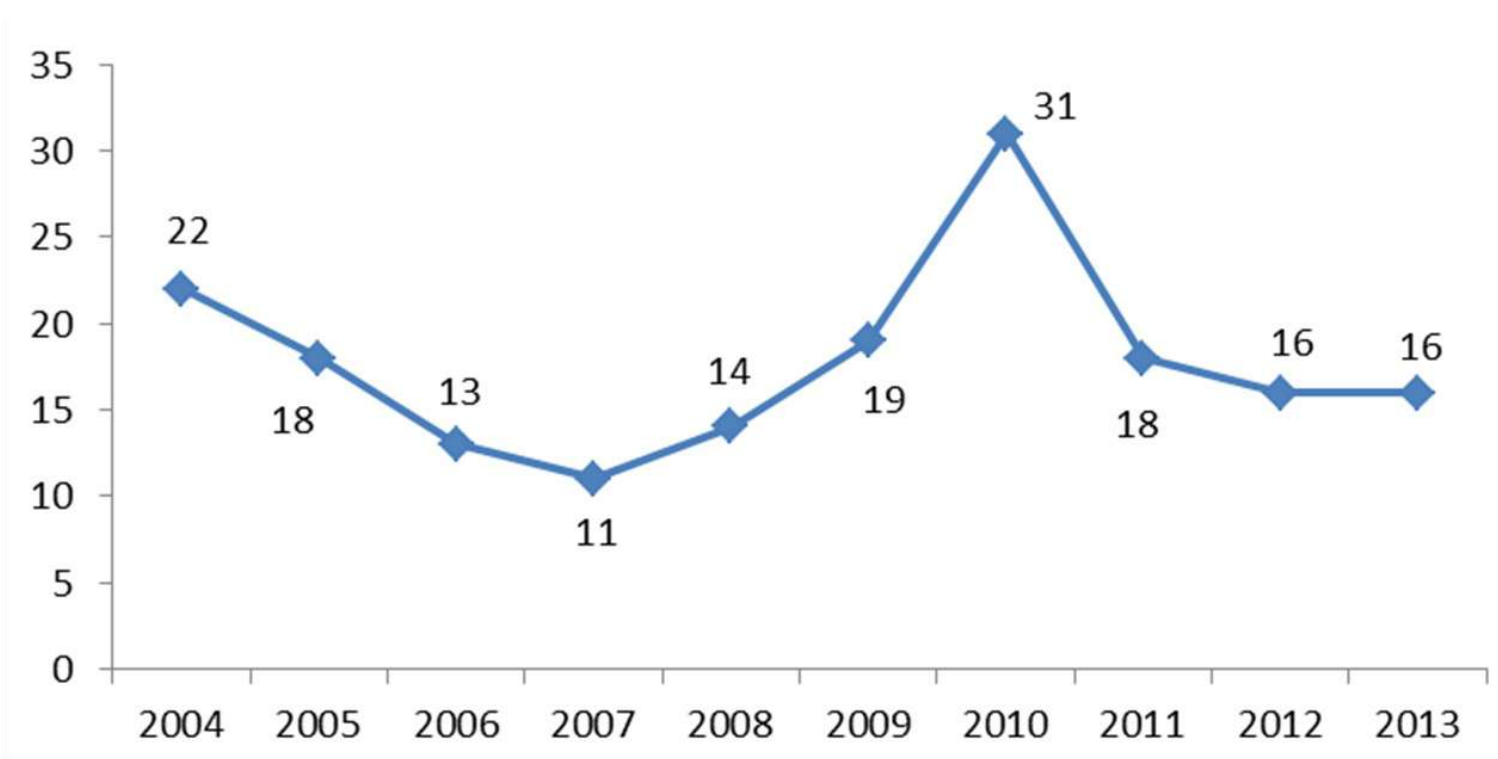
Household Income Distribution



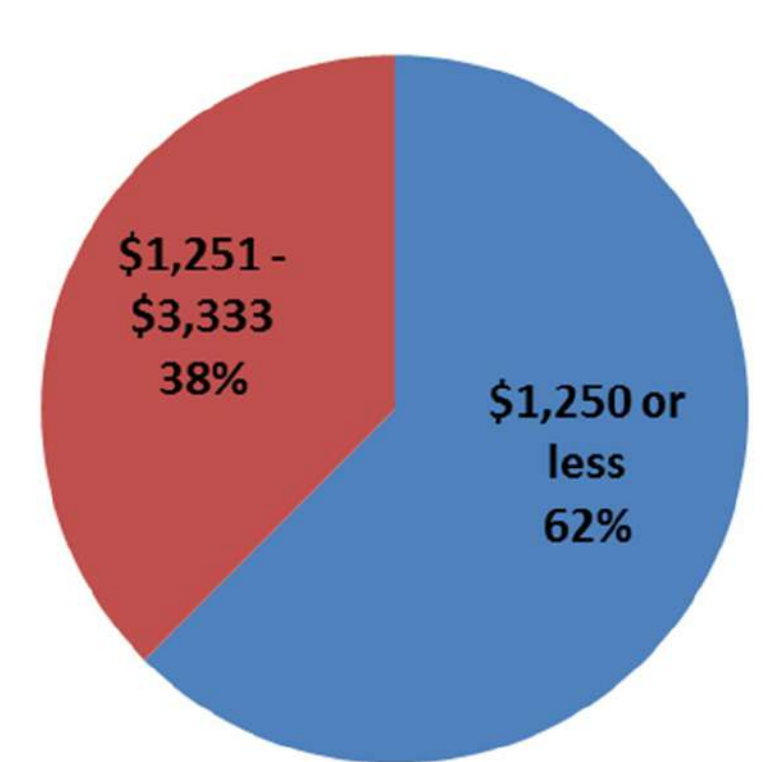
VOLGA

- Overall 33% population decline since 1980
- Flooding has had a major impact
- Well-distributed age grouping—the 65+ year age group is the smallest, 45-64 is the largest
- Newcomers in the 25-34, 40-49 & 55-64 year age ranges
- Population projected to continue to decline
- Most jobs in Public Administration
- Job counts over the past decade have been somewhat steady, other than a spike in 2010
- Median household income = \$37,150
- 38% of jobs pay 15-40k; 62% pay less than 15k
- 15 people commute into the city for work, 73 leave for work, and 1 stays in the city for work

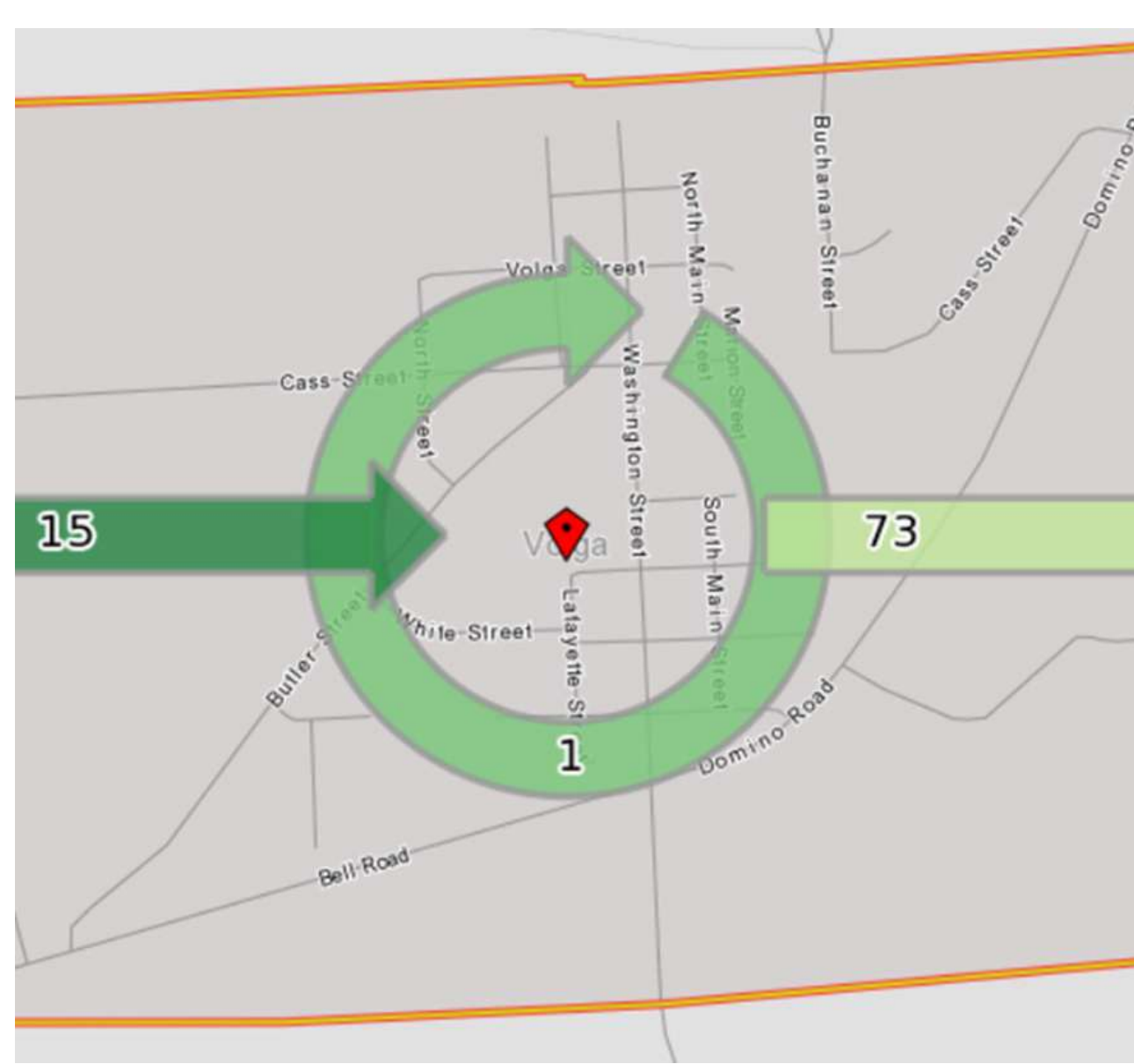
Job Count
