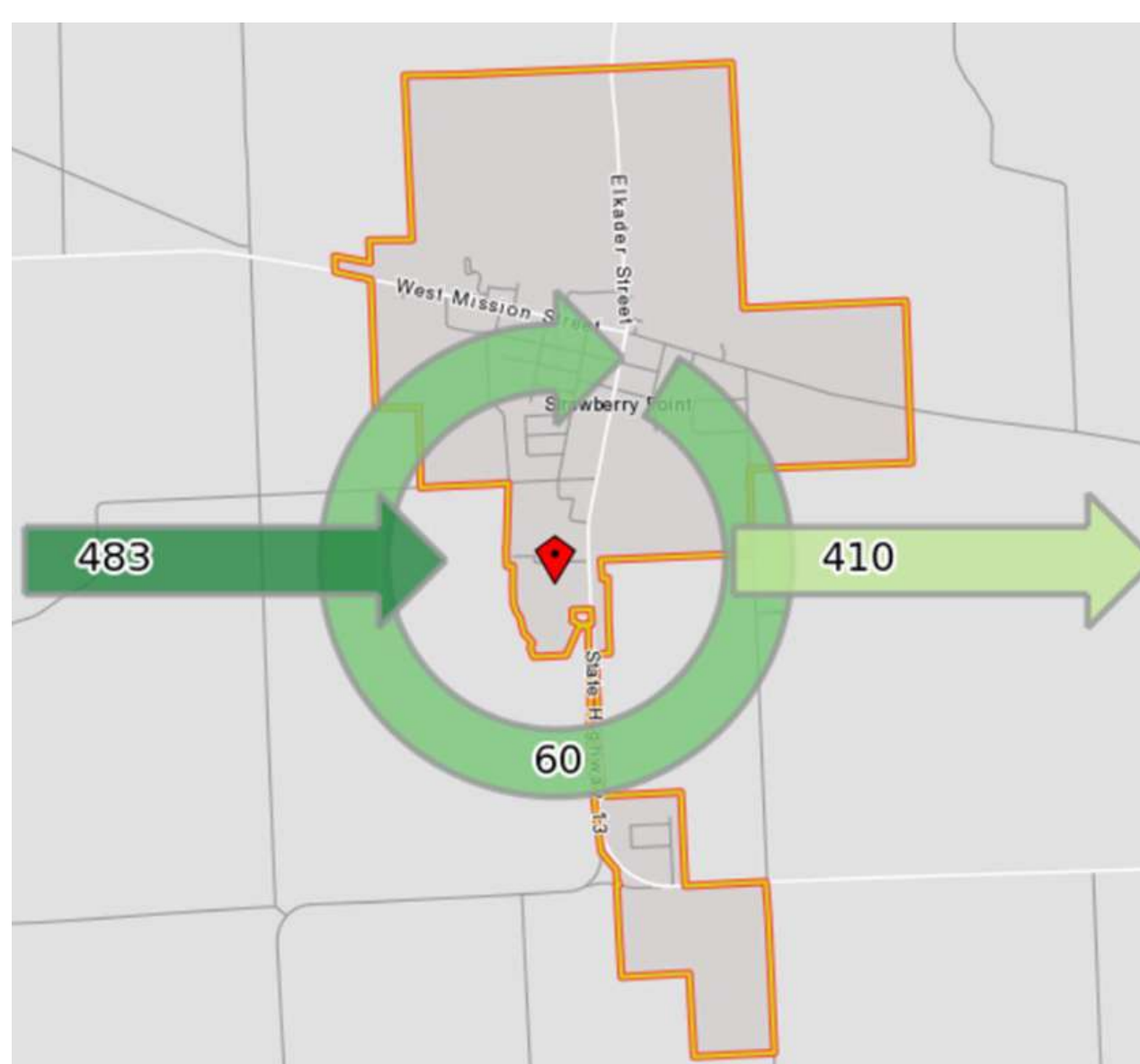
STRAWBERRY POINT

- ↑ Overall 13% population decline since 1980
- ↑ Well-distributed age grouping—the 45-64 year age group is the largest
- ↑ Most newcomers in the 25-29 & 45-59 year age ranges
- ↑ Population projected to have a slight increase
- ↑ Most jobs in Construction
- ↑ Job counts over the past decade have fluctuated somewhat, with a low of 466 in 2006 to a high of 552 in 2012
- ↑ Median household income = \$42,988
- ↑ 38% of jobs pay 15-40k; 42% pay more than 40k; and 20% pay less than 15k
- ↑ 483 people commute into the city for work, 410 leave for work, and 60 stay in the city for work
