

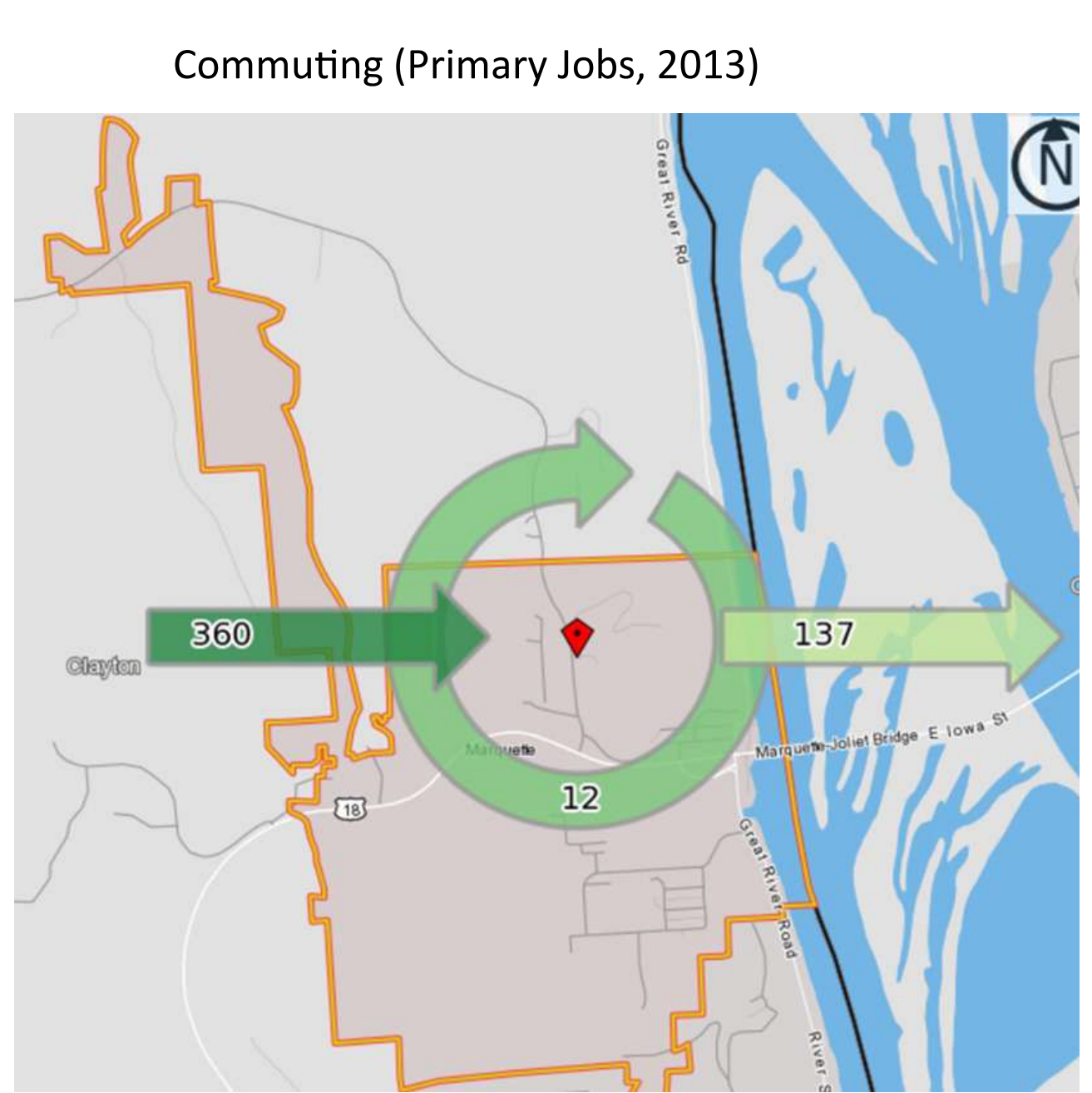
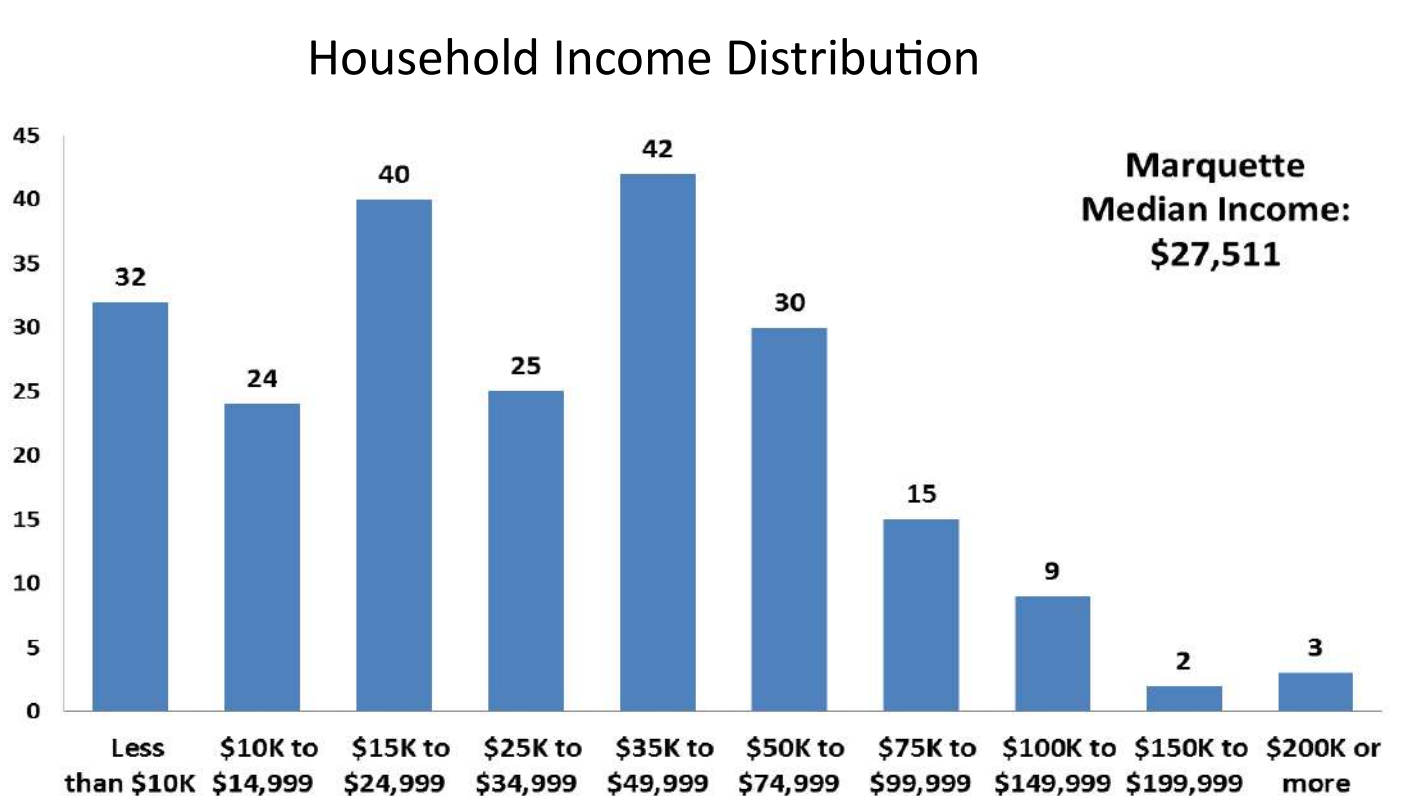
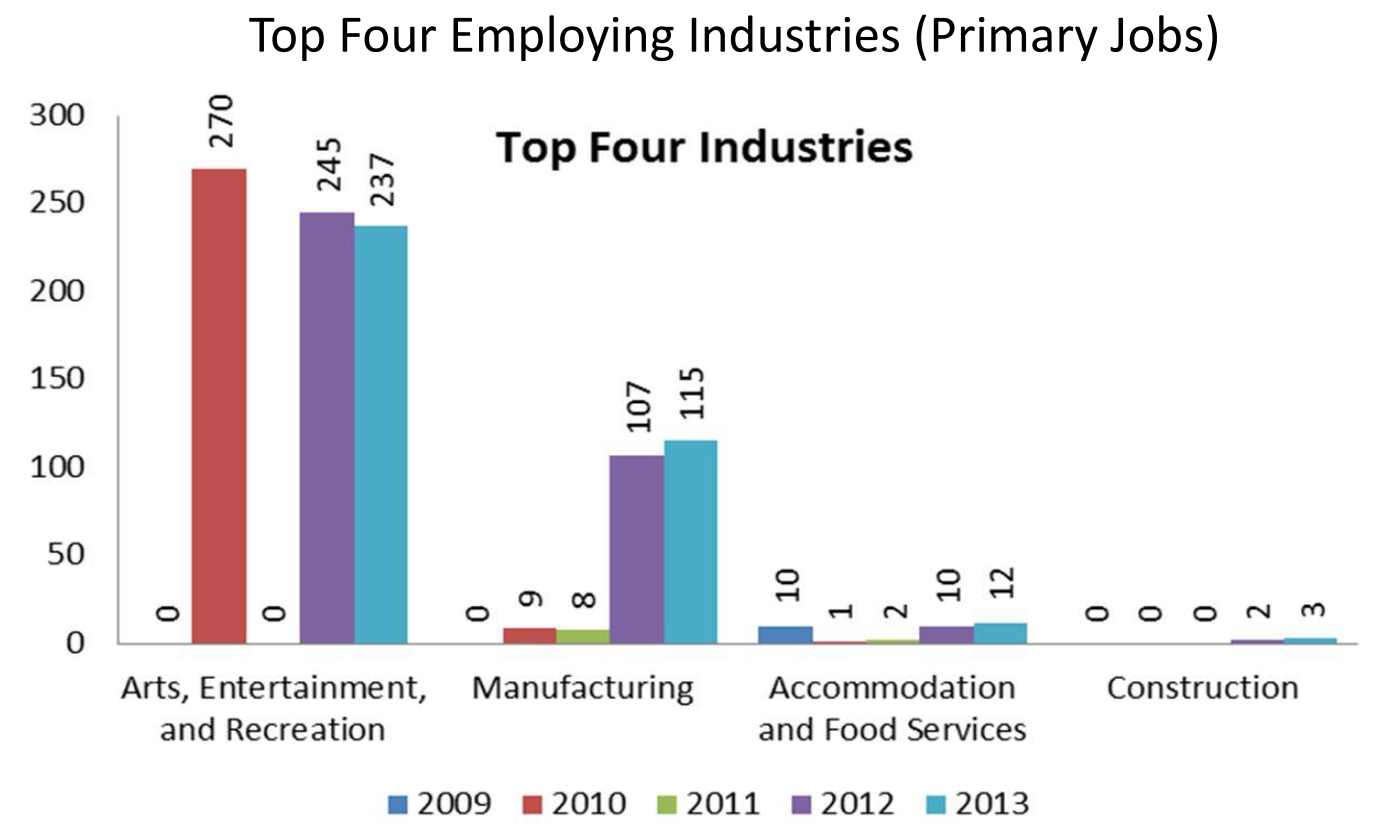
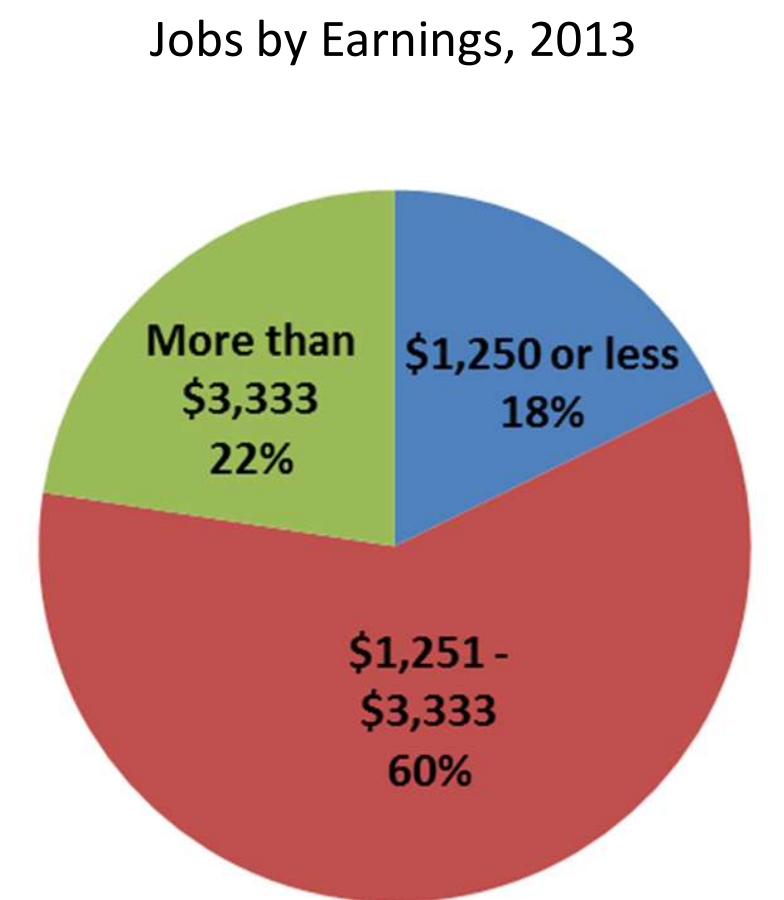
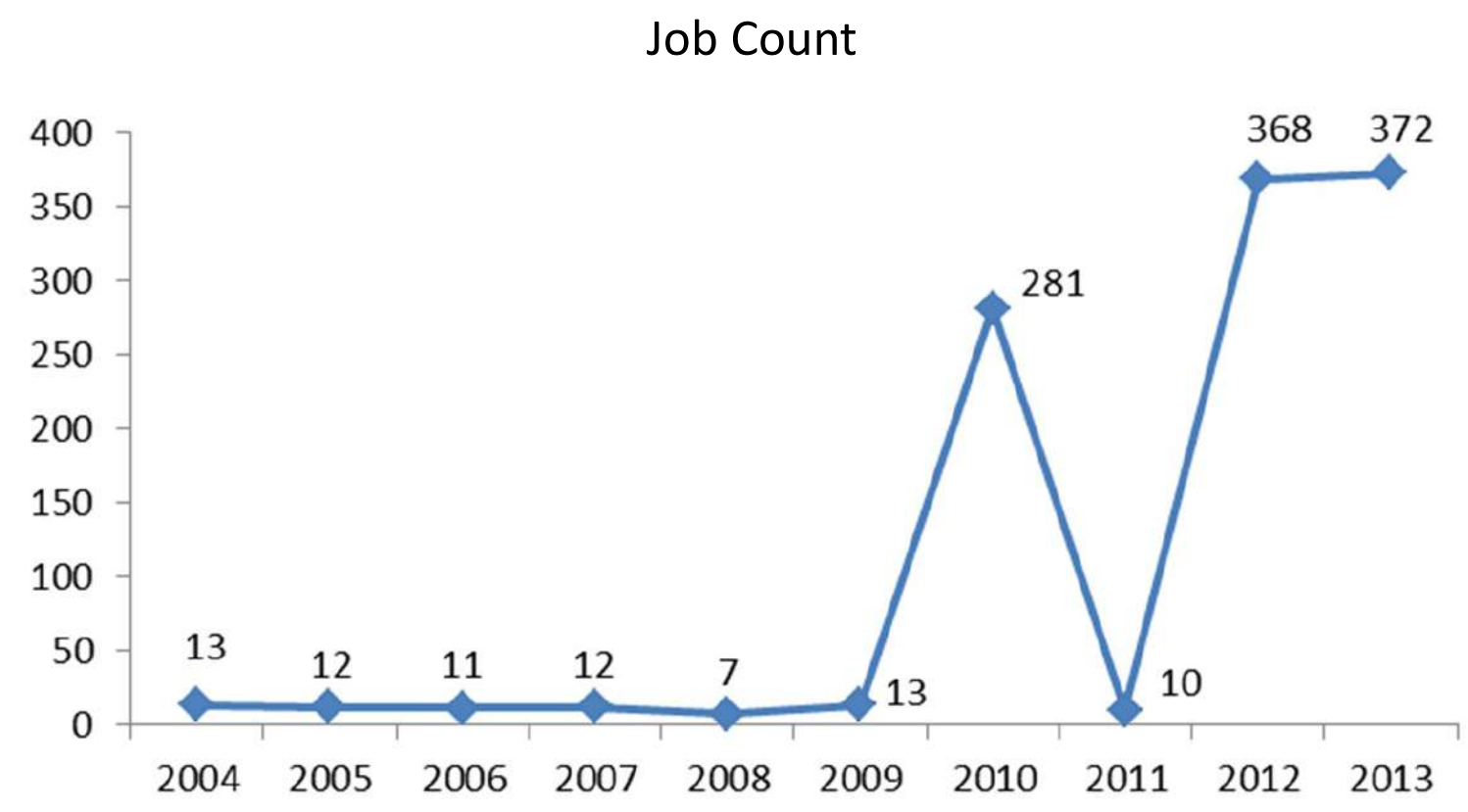
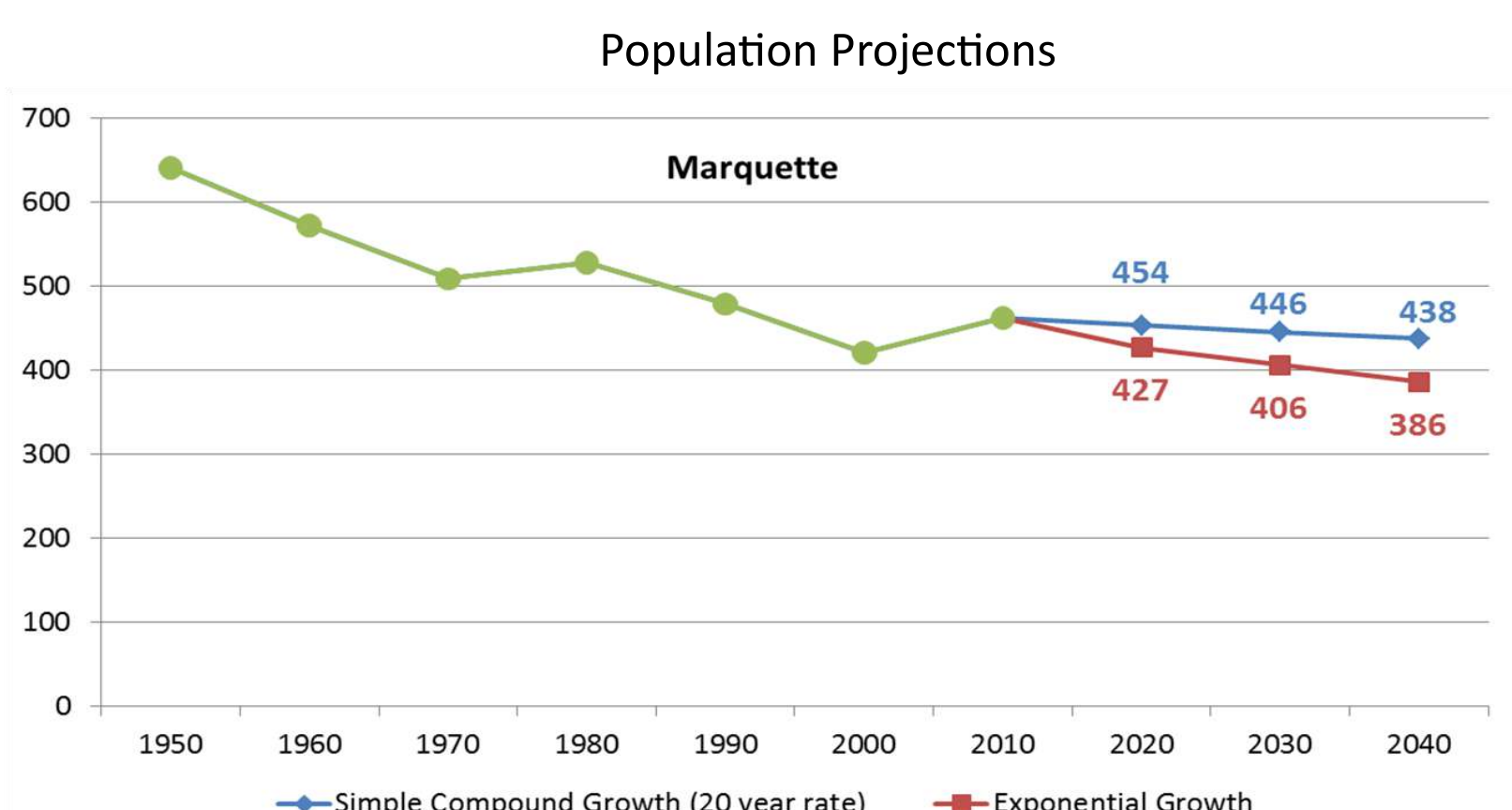
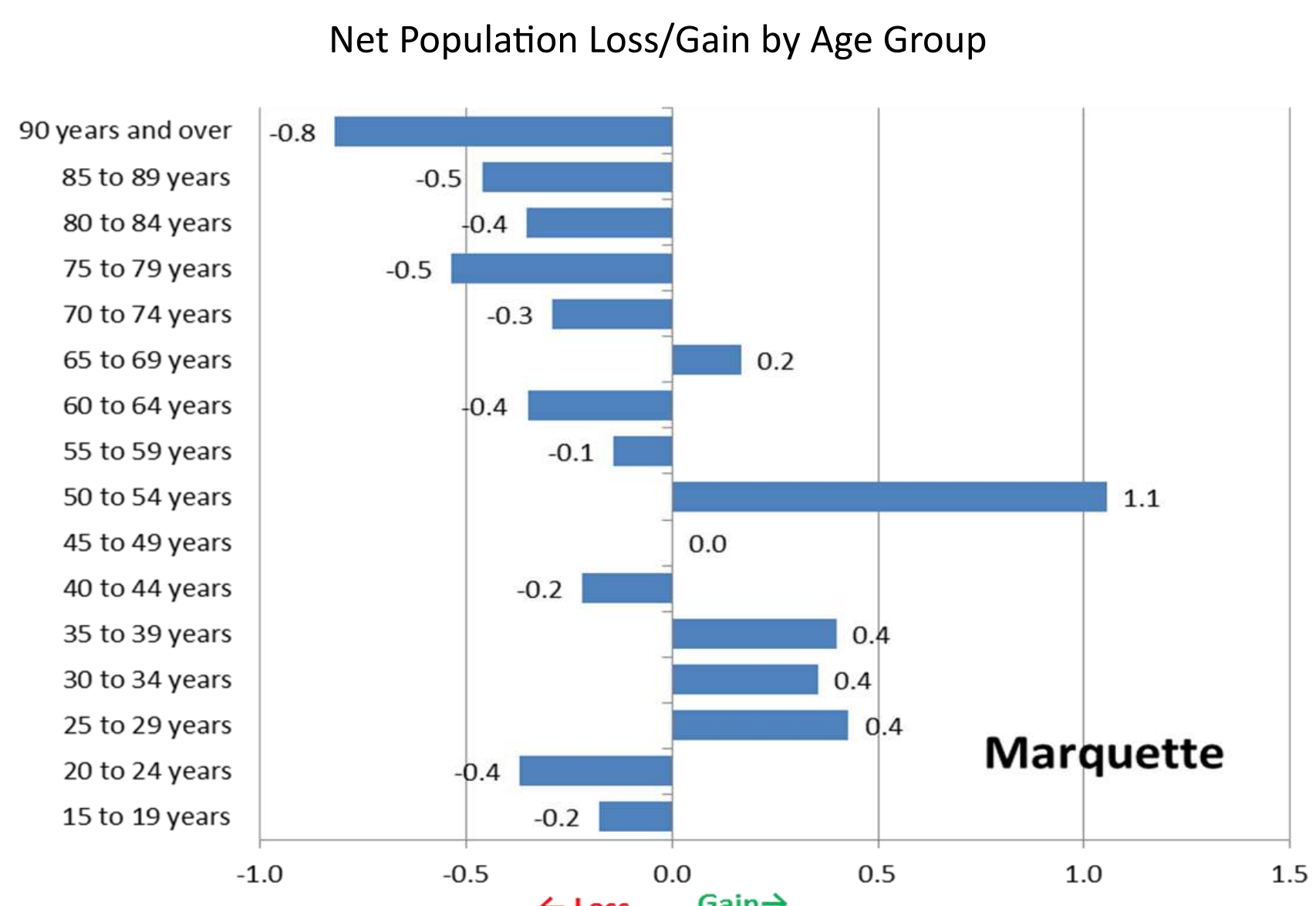
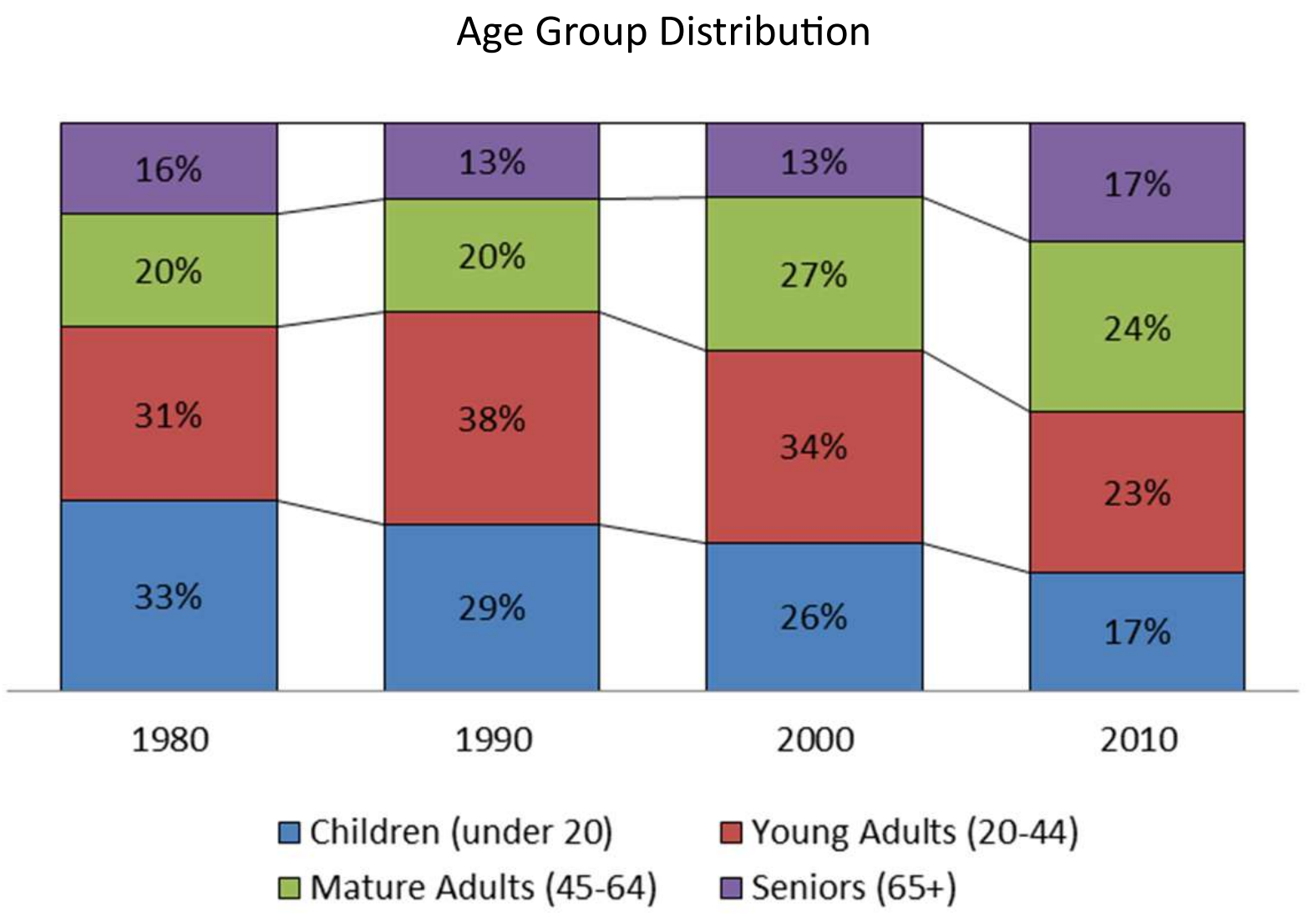
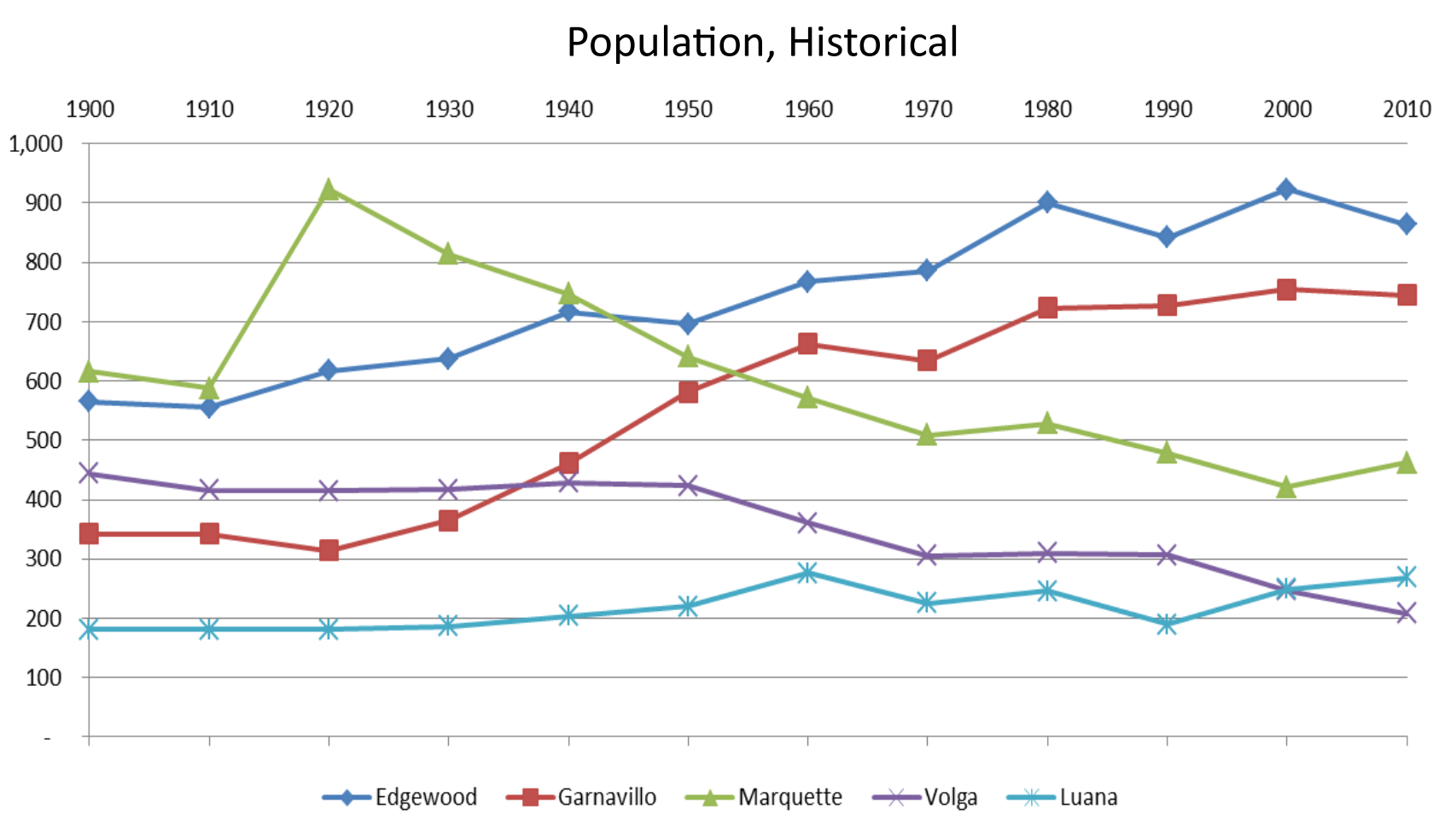
What We Learned



From Data

MARQUETTE

- ↑ Overall 13% population decline since 1980
- ↑ Well-distributed age grouping—the 0-20 year age group is the smallest & 65+ is the largest
- ↑ Newcomers in the 25-29 & 50-54 year age ranges
- ↑ Population projected to have a slight decrease
- ↑ Most jobs in Arts, Entertainment & Recreation
- ↑ Job counts over the past decade have fluctuated, with a low of 7 in 2008 to a high of 372 in 2013
- ↑ Median household income = \$27,511
- ↑ 60% of jobs pay 15-40k; 22% pay more than 40k; and 18% pay less than 15k
- ↑ 360 people commute into the city for work, 137 leave for work, and 12 stay in the city for work
