

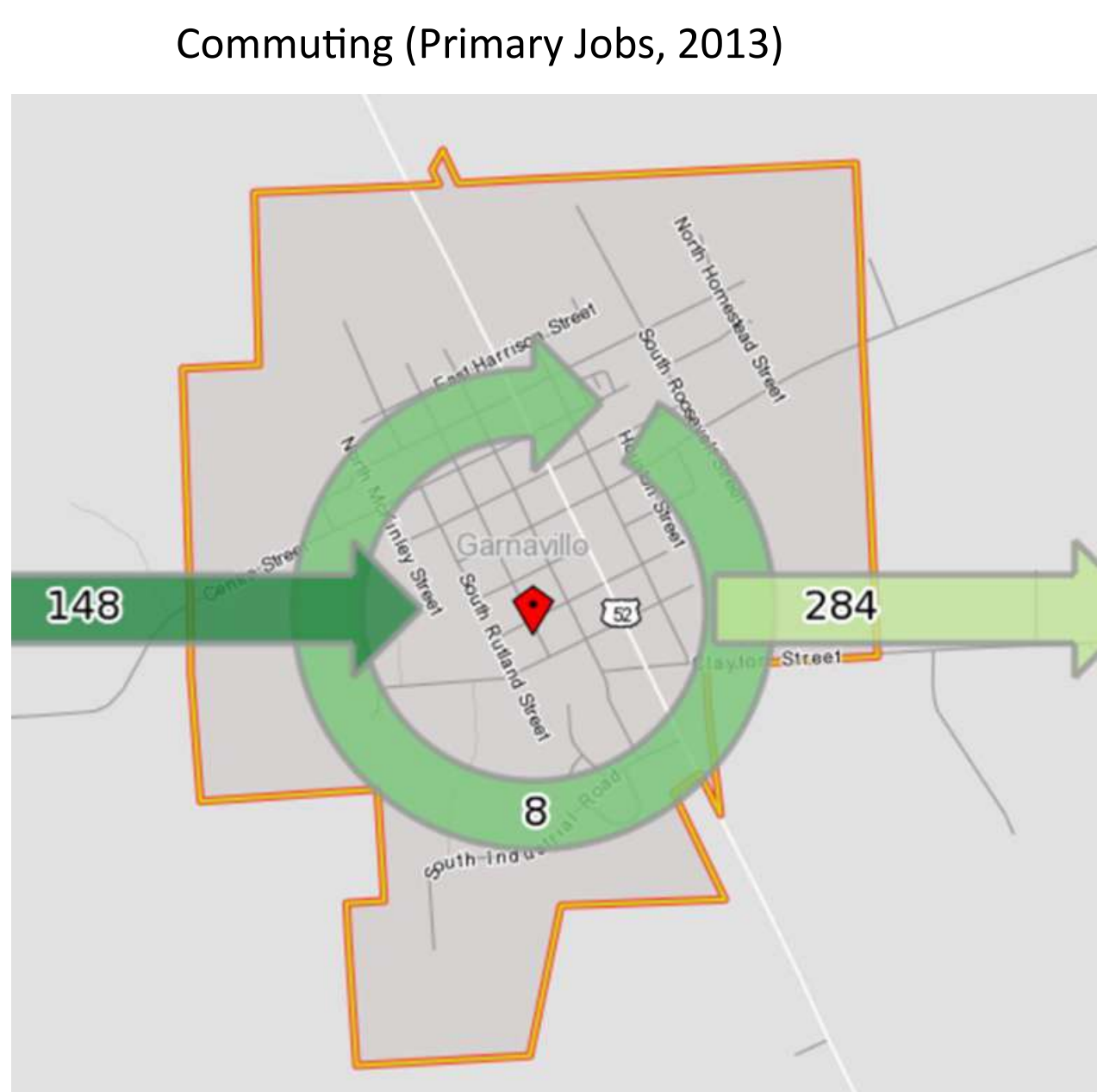
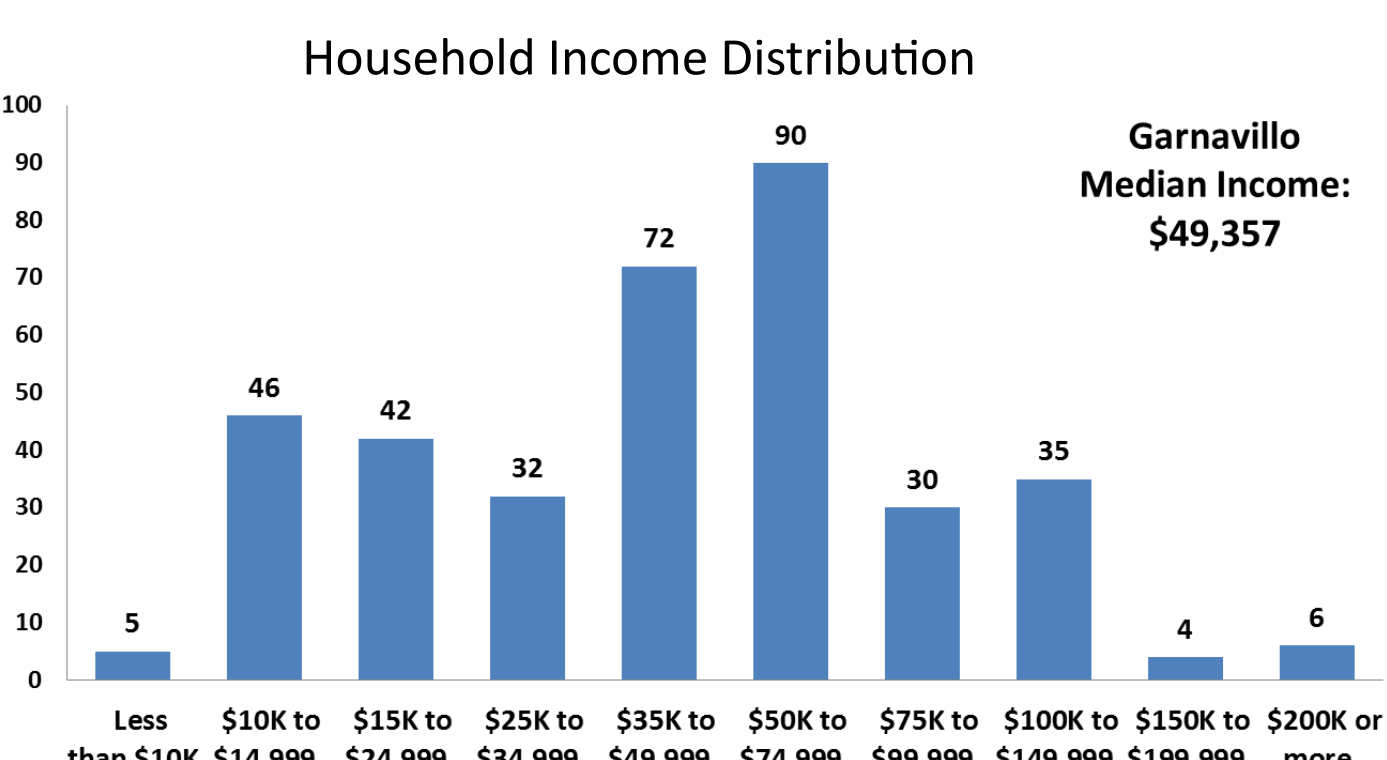
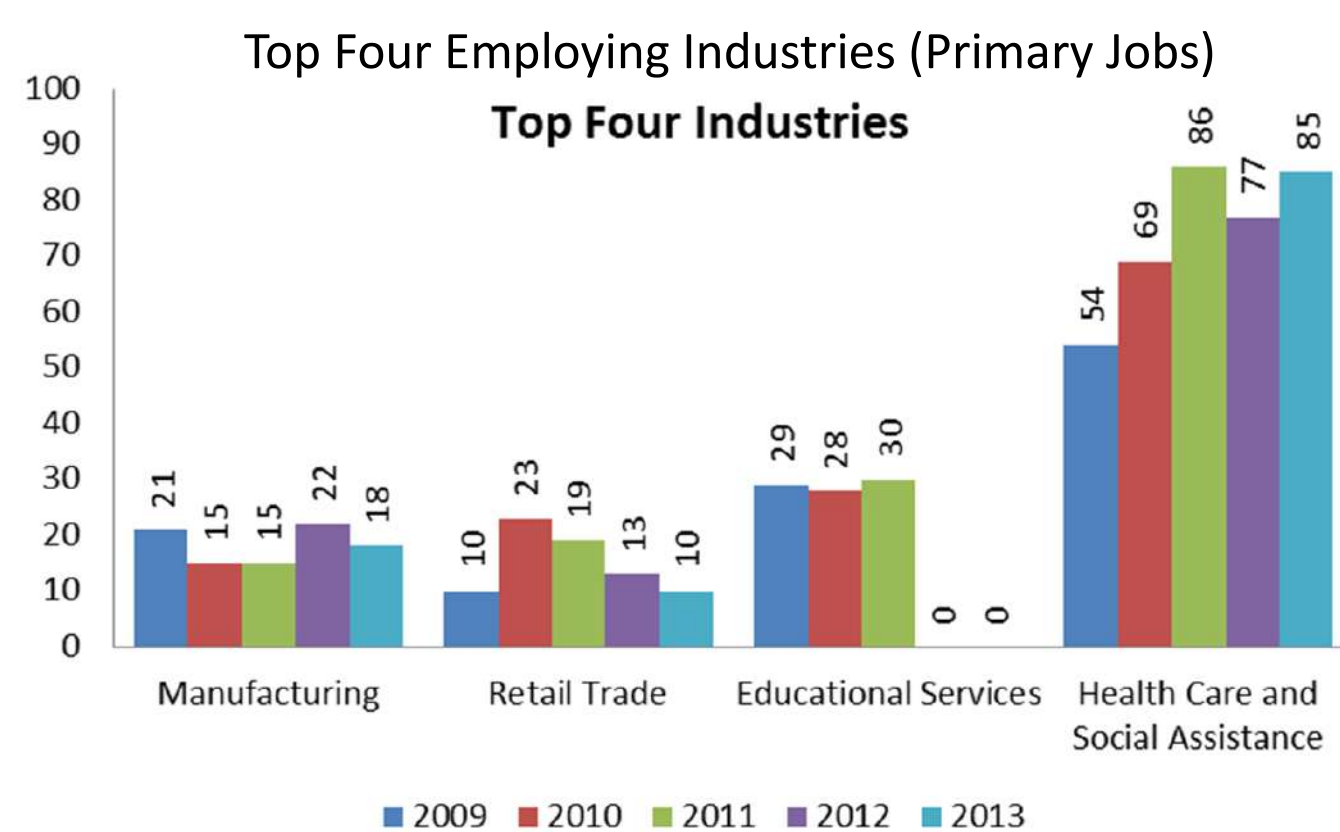
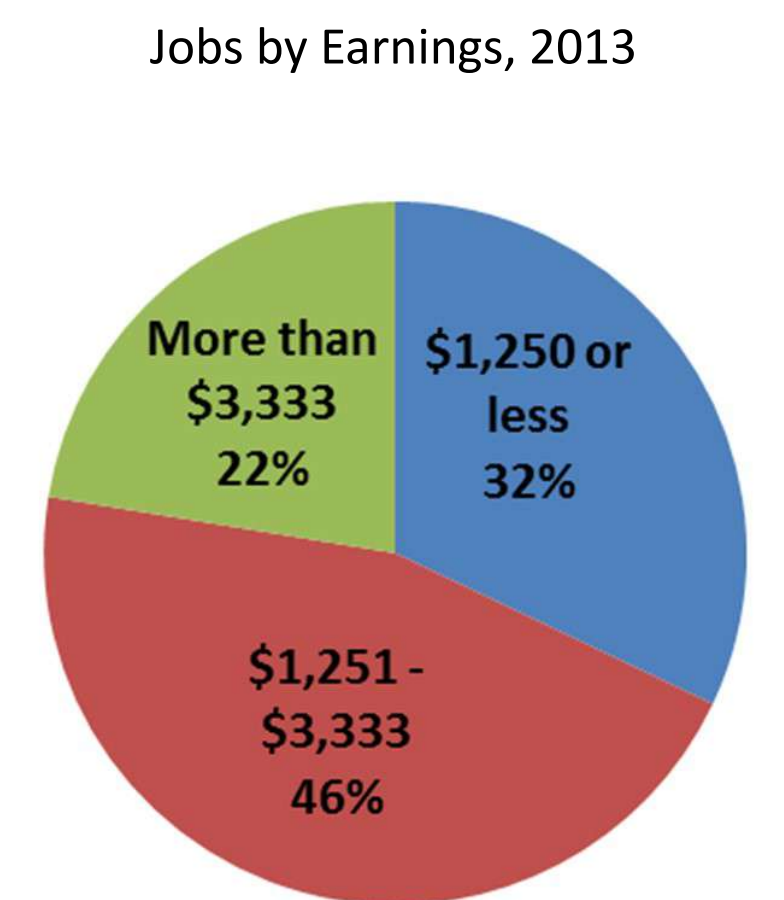
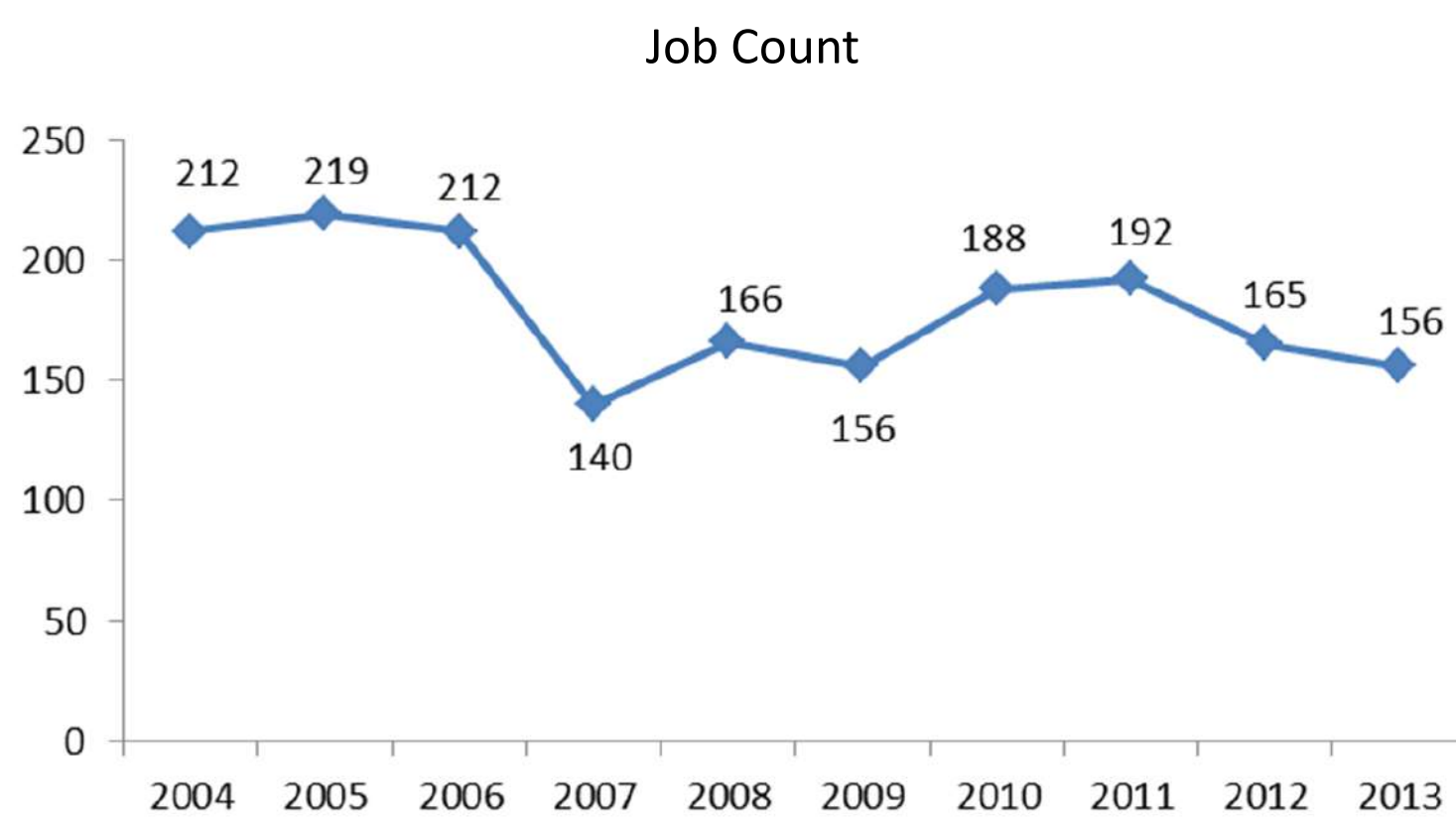
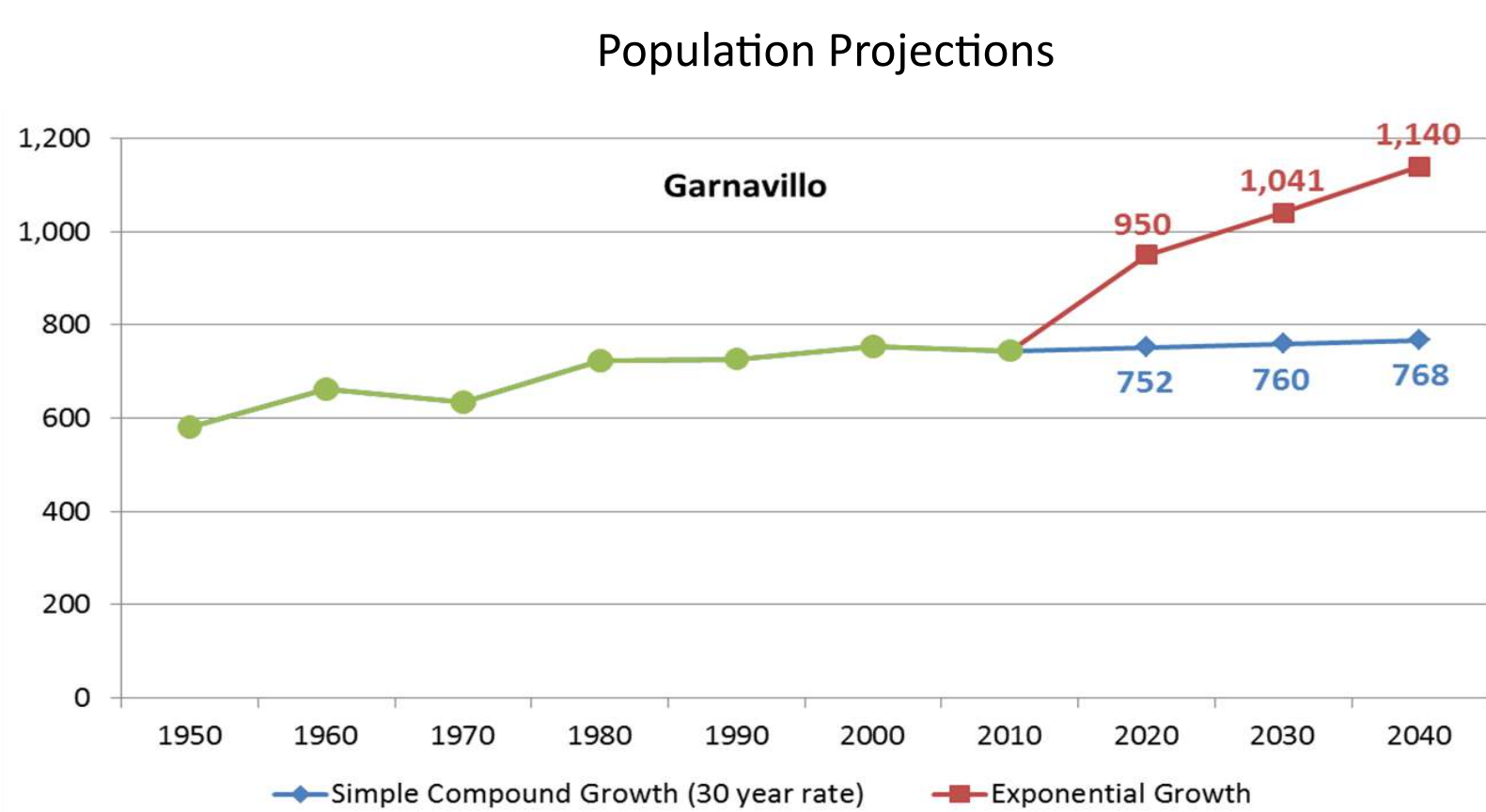
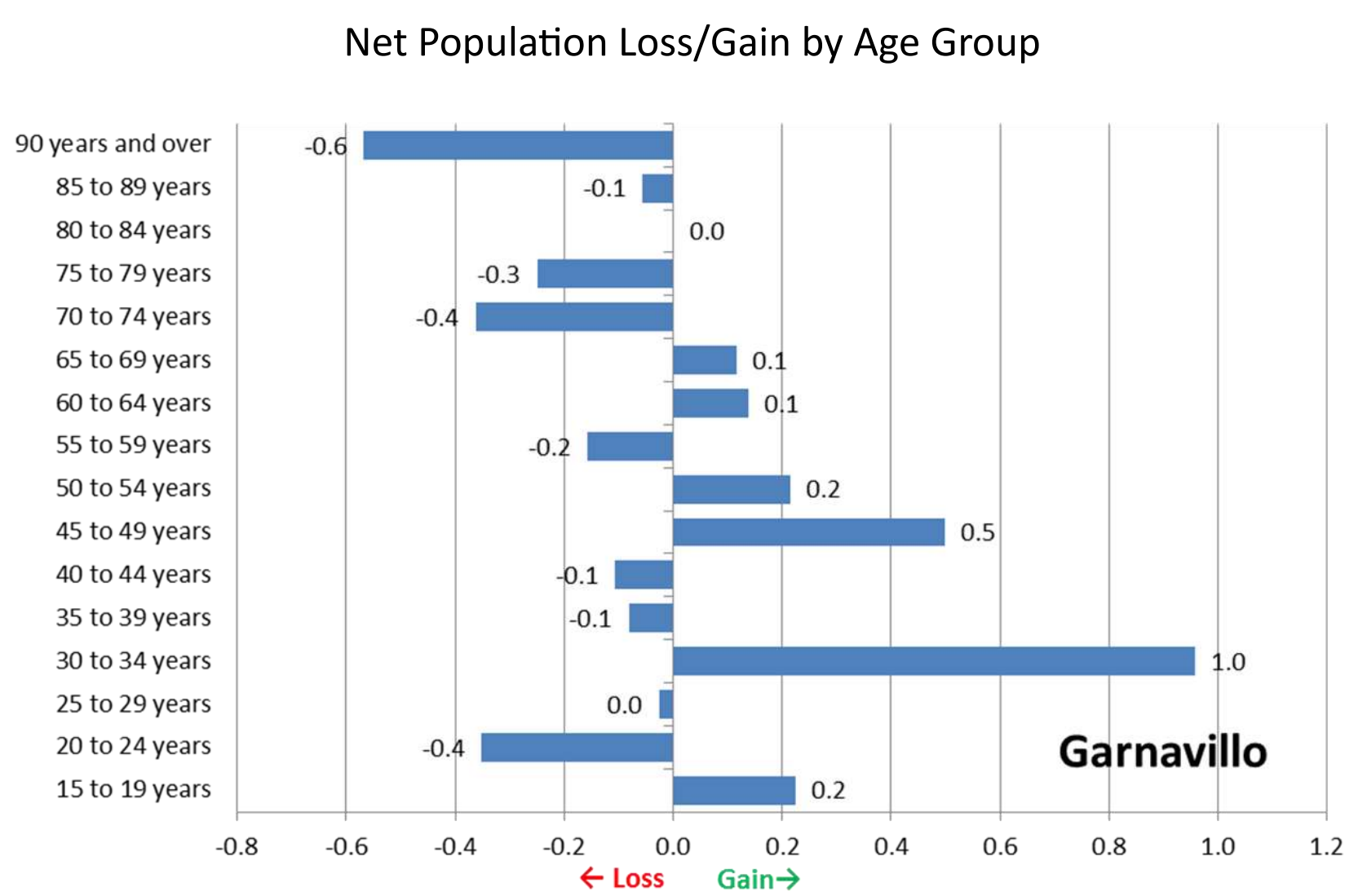
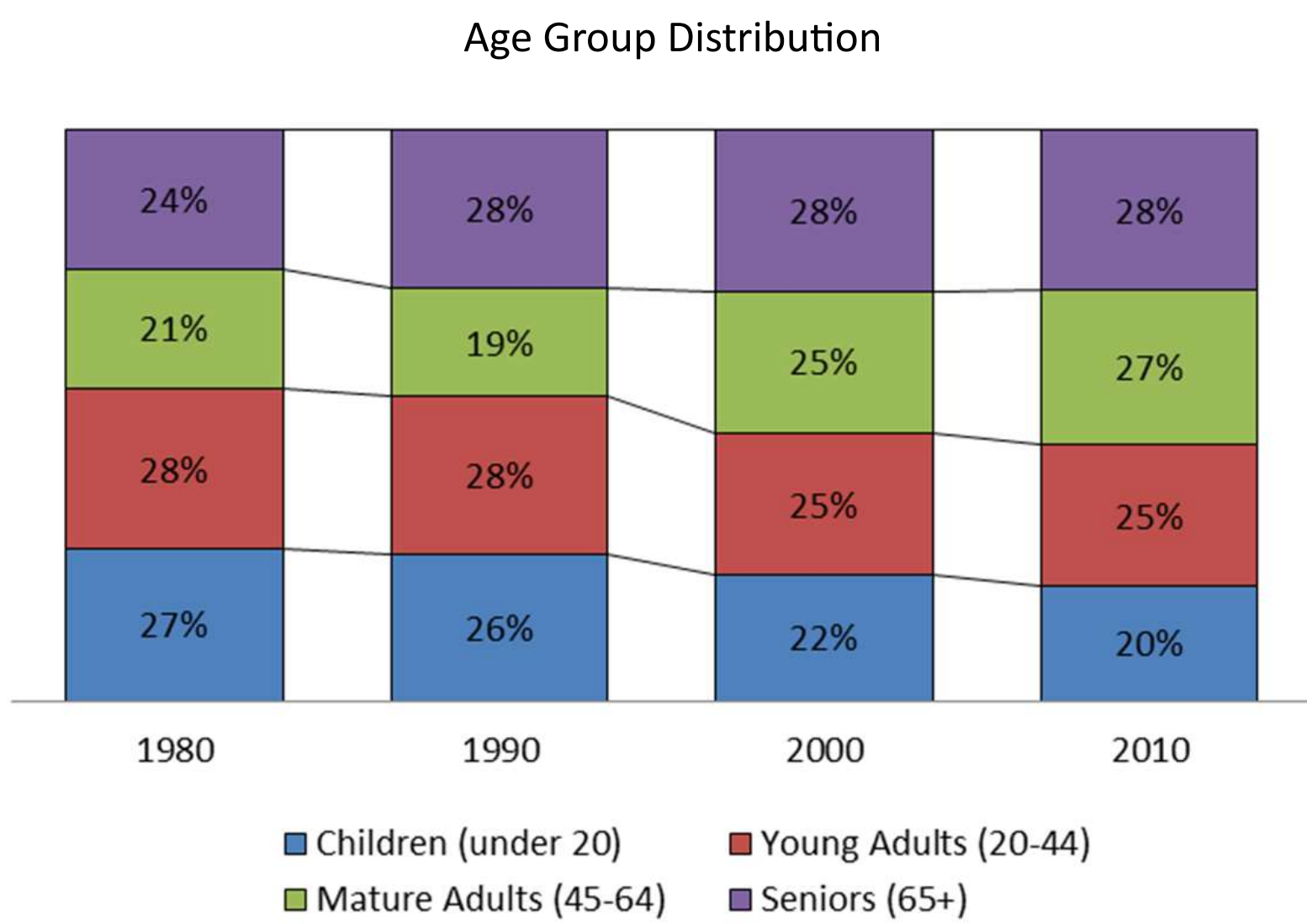
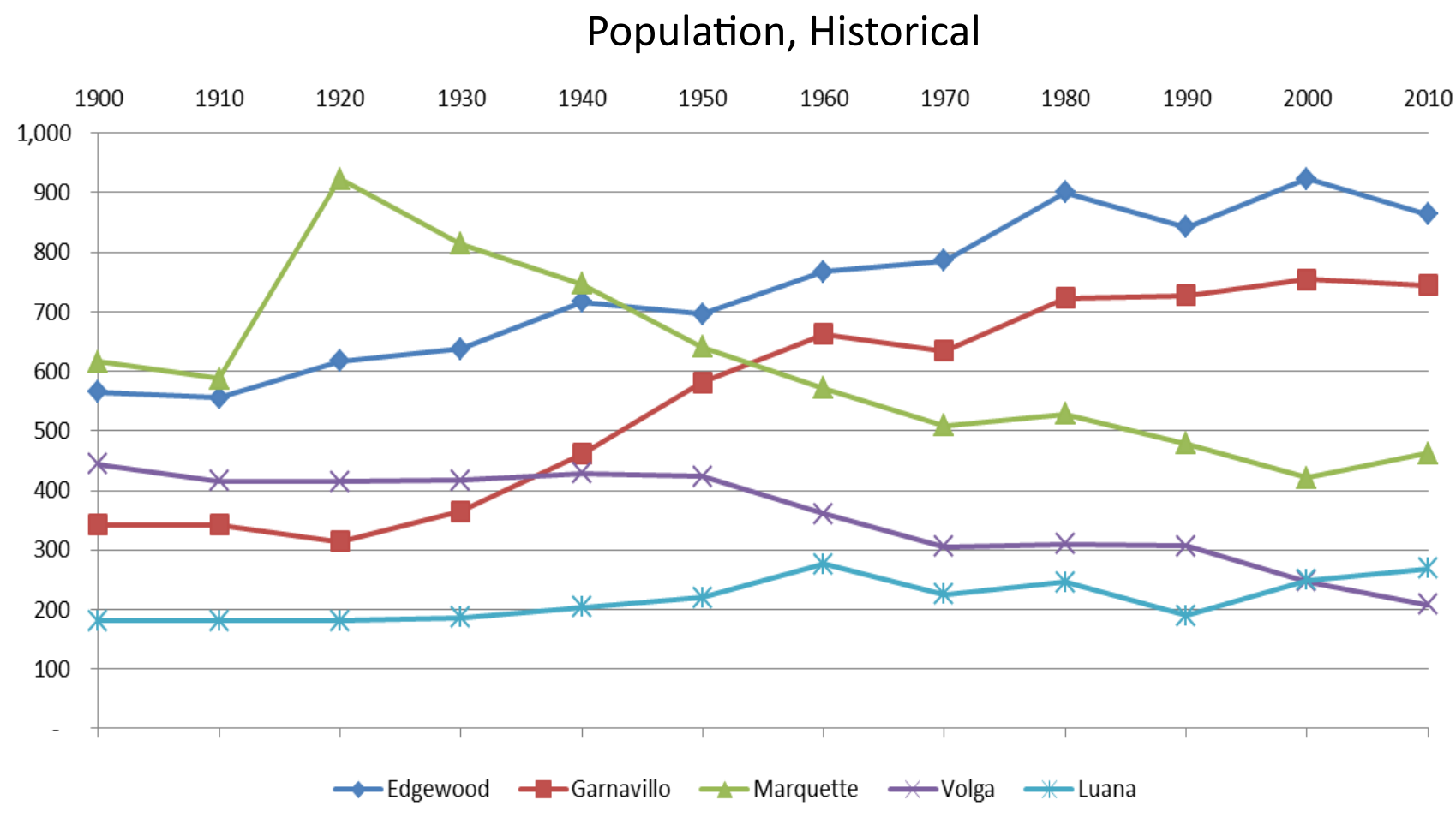
# What We Learned



## From Data

### GARNAVILLO

- ↑ Overall 3% population increase since 1980
- ↑ Well-distributed age grouping—the 0-20 year age group is the smallest
- ↑ Most newcomers are in the 30-34 & 45-49 year age ranges
- ↑ Population projected to continue to increase
- ↑ Most jobs in Health Care
- ↑ Job counts over the past decade have fluctuated, with a high of 219 in 2005 to a low of 140 in 2007
- ↑ Median household income = \$49,357, that's 3% higher than the county
- ↑ 46% of jobs pay 15-40k; 22% pay more than 40k; and 32% pay less than 15k
- ↑ 148 people commute into the city for work, 284 leave for work, and 8 stay in the city for work
